Projects

- Android and/or iOS: the choice is up to you
- Group projects, properly scaled, are permitted
- Groups can be have up to three members
- The individual contribution of each member must be clear and balanced

Projects

- You must use at least 3 components described during class
 - for example: networking, data persistence, multimedia
- UI is considered a component
- Projects will be evaluated for the mobile component only
 - projects can rely on a server-side component but it will not be evaluated
 - mock-up server data is totally fine

Projects

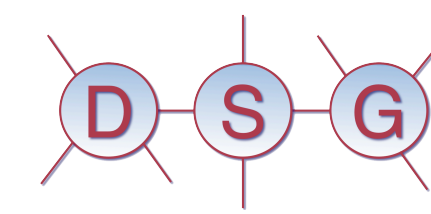
- All projects must be approved by the teachers
- All communication **MUST** have both teachers involved (don't forget to CC and Reply-to-all)
- **Send an email with your project proposal:**
 - what is the application doing?
 - target platform?
 - used components?
- Before starting, wait for approval
- UI/UX should also be discussed with the teachers to avoid design errors

Projects

- All projects must be presented with a short presentation with slides describing the work that has been performed
- Presentation dates must be agreed upon with the teachers by email
- You can present your app anytime, just send an email to the teachers when you are ready to agree on a date (no strict deadline)

Project Presentation

- Presentations (10/15 minutes) should be structured in a way to clearly show:
 - objective of the application
 - components used
 - in case of group projects, roles in the group so that it is clear what is the contribution of each member
 - overview of the main features of the app with a flow diagram and highlighting the main platform components used to implement a particular feature or module
 - [optional] demo: the teachers will also run the application when the app is delivered
- **Use the templates that we will post on the website!**
- We would like to give you a chance to present your work properly in order to learn how to talk to people about technical features and your work in general (very important for your careers!)
